### **TUCKSHOP**

Unfortunately the cost of food, sweets and cold drinks supplied to our tuckshop has increased over the past few months. Please remember to allow your child to load money onto their tuckshop account in the office with Mrs Wyer to purchase from the tuck shop, as it does not accept cash. Orders can be placed in the morning for food and drink at the tuckshop with Mrs Lotter. Your child will not be allowed to buy if they do not have money in their tuckshop account.
