WELCOME

UNIFORM

All learners should be wearing their winter uniform. Grey or red scarves, beanies and gloves are allowed. Learners will receive an automatic break detention if they do not wear a tie to school, ties are compulsory. Grey socks, not white please. Please ensure that your child is dressed correctly.

Girls: grey tunic or grey long pants; white long-sleeved school shirt; school tie; grey knee-length socks (with red stripes if the tunic is worn); black school shoes; school jersey. The school beanie and school scarf are optional.

Grade 4-7 girls must wear the school blazer

Gr R-3 girls can wear the Drymac instead of a blazer

Earrings: girls may wear plain silver or gold studs or sleepers only. No fancy earrings are allowed.

Boys: Grey long school pants; white long-sleeved school shirt; school tie; grey knee-length socks; black school shoes; school jersey. The school beanie and school scarf are optional.

School tracksuits are to be worn on Tuesdays and Thursday only. Most of the above clothing may be bought from Mrs Wyer in the office.

Drymacs may be order from Mrs Massey (Gr 2). Drymacs cost R200 (cash only). The cost of the Drymac may not be added to your school fee account. Delivery: approximately 12 days after the order is placed and paid for in cash. No tracksuit tops!
