WELCOME

UNIFORM

All learners should be wearing their winter uniform by now. Grey or red scarves, beanies and gloves are allowed. Learners will receive an automatic break detention if they do not wear a tie to school, ties are compulsory. Grey socks, not white please. Please ensure that your child is dressed correctly.

Girls: grey tunic or grey long pants; white long-sleeved school shirt; school tie; grey knee-length socks (with red stripes if the tunic is worn); black school shoes; school jersey. The school beanie and school scarf are optional.
